

[Information of entry to Korea regarding COVID-19]

* Students who are entering Korea from overseas are required to be in quarantine for 7 days. Students are allowed to attend class after their quarantine is over. (as of May 19th, 2022 (KST).)

Students who put their vaccination information beforehand through Q-code are exempted from quarantine.

※ The definition of 'fully-vaccinated'

▶ Those who are vaccinated twice (for Johnson & Johnson's Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine, once) and 14 to 180 days have passed from their last day of vaccination.

▶ How to receive the QR code: Type in the information in the Q-CODE system and after receiving the QR code, use it to verify your vaccination.

* Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination required to be uploaded through Q-CODE system

After being in quarantine, if there are any symptoms of respiratory disease (coughing, sore throat, shortness of breath, pneumonia), do not come to class and call 120 with area code or 1339 without area code (for Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency), 1345 without area code (for Immigration Contact Center) for instructions.
